The Operations Specialist will report to the Operations Managers and support the day -to-day operations of Seattle-based tours out of our local office. We run tours for Evergreen Escapes and Seattle Mountain Bike Tours. This is a hands-on, detail-oriented roll that ensures guides have all they need to run a successful tour in the field. The ideal candidate is extremely reliable, a strong communicator, and self-directed with role responsibilities.

POSITION DETAILS & COMPENSATION

We are hiring two part-time, seasonal positions May-October. This position will be three to four days a week (some weeks might have an additional shift) and the general shift hours will fall between 6:00am-2:00pm, for a total of 15-30 hours per week. Early morning shifts are required as well as at least 1 weekend day per week (Saturday or Sunday) and most holidays (Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, etc.) are required from May-October as this is our busiest season of the year.
